**OVERNIGHT CAMPERS**

The University of North Alabama has just completed its 5th year under the guidance of Head Football Coach Mark Hudspeth. The Lions finished the 2006 campaign with a 11-1 record and the Gulf South Conference Championship. UNA also advanced to the 3rd round of the NCAA Playoffs. Coach Hud, as he is known, has an overall head coaching record of 69-18 and a record of 44-17 in his first 5 years at UNA. He has won more games in his first 5 years than any other coach in UNA history, as he has led UNA to 2 GSC Championships and 3 trips to the NCAA Playoffs, including two trips to the NCAA Semi Finals.

Coach Hud is also entering his 11th year to direct or be a part of OL/DL Camp. **UNA OL/DL Camp** is one of the few and most respected OL/DL camps in the country. Last season, players from eight states attended to prepare themselves for a great football season.

Averaging 35 points per game for the 5th consecutive year, UNA will once again offer the "Spread Offense" Skill Camp. UNA's four wide "no-huddle" attack has lead the Lions to a 40-10 record during the last four years, including six NCAA playoff games.

## SENIOR CAMP

June 2, 2007

UNA Senior Camp is for all upcoming 2008 Seniors.

UNA Senior Camp is specifically designed to increase your exposure and your knowledge of the University of North Alabama from an athletic and academic standpoint.

At **UNA Senior Camp** each camper will be given a tour of the UNA Football facilities and the UNA Campus. Admission representatives will inform campers of UNA's different areas of study, admission standards and ACT dates.

- Campers will be timed in the 40 yard dash, Pro Shuttle. Players will also perform a bench press test.
- After testing, players will receive position specific instruction on the field from the UNA Coaching Staff.
- All players will fill out questionnaires that will be put into the UNA recruiting database.
- Lunch will be provided
- UNA Camp T-shirt will be provided
- Only cleats, tennis shoes and work out gear will be needed. **NO HELMETS.**
- Registration begins at 9 AM and ends at 10 AM at the UNA Practice Field adjacent to Flowers Hall.

## OL/DL CAMP

June 23-25, 2007

It's **work time** again and there is no better place to prepare yourself for a championship season than at the **University of North Alabama OL/DL Camp**. UNA OL/DL Camp enters its 6th season and has become one of the top football camps in the country for the amount of work and quality instruction you will receive. Instruction is given by the UNA coaching staff along with other top college and high school coaches.

UNA OL/DL Camp is for players and teams that want to take it to the **next level!** It is not a typical football and activity camp – its sole purpose is to prepare **OL, DL, TE and LBers** for trench warfare!

As always at OL/DL Camp agility and conditioning will also be stressed.

What better way to prepare and push yourself both physically and mentally and develop team unity than by working together for three days this summer at **UNA OL/DL Camp!**

**Offensive Linemen/TEs** will be drilled on all phases of OL play, fundamentals and techniques such as: drive block, zone, veer, trap and scoops. Pass protection skills such as drop back, quick game, slide and sprint will be stressed. TEs will also be drilled in route running and ball drills.

**Defensive Linemen** will be drilled in the fundamentals of attacking, recognizing and defeating blocks such as the reach, down, counters and traps. Pass rush techniques will also be stressed along with zone drops, stemming, pursuit angles and ball get off.

**LBers** will be drilled in all areas of recognition and defeating blockers, coverage drops and blitz technique.

**DBs** will be included this year to allow teams to bring their entire defense. DBs will be drilled in tackling, coverage skills, footwork and fundamentals.

**Team and Big Man Challenge** gives each team and individuals a chance to compete against other schools and players the last day of camp. Trophies will be awarded to the winners.

## SPREAD OFFENSE CAMP

June 23-25, 2007

Unlike other camps, UNA's Offensive "Spread" Camp is an affordable camp for your players and coaches to learn a proven system that has averaged **35 points a game**, won two Gulf South Conference Championships and been to the NCAA Playoffs three times, including two trips to the Semi Finals. UNA's **"No Huddle-NO WRISTBAND"** system includes a balanced attack of running and passing the football. Coaching staffs who bring players will be given our entire system through offensive "buzz" sessions and film study each night – free of charge.

UNA Spread Offense Camp is for players who are entering 9th thru 12th grade. It is a three day work camp designed to enhance the skills necessary to play in a "Spread" offense. This camp is designed for all offensive skill positions (QB, RB, WR, TE).

**QBs** will learn all of the fundamentals of being a "Spread Offense" QB including drops, meshes, option reads & pitches, and passing the football.

**RBs** will be drilled on all phases of RB play including footwork, meshes and options from depth, ball security, pass protection and routes out of the backfield.

**WRs** will be drilled in all phases of footwork, ball drills, routes, screens, speed sweeps, blocking and option pitch relationships out of the gun.

**TEs** will be drilled on all phases of footwork, ball drills, routes, screens and blocking.

Each position will be working on fundamentals individually and as a group. Proper mechanics of the QB/RB Mesh, Options, Speed Sweeps and passing progressions will be taught.

Due to an increase in demand this camp will have a cut off number. Early registration is advised.

## "AIR IT OUT" 7 ON 7

July 14, 2007

UNA's "Air it Out" 7 on 7 Team Competition gives each team an opportunity to compete against other programs and perfect their game that they have been practicing all summer. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 5 games. A three game round robin format will be used in the morning and a double elimination format in the evening.

- A Championship trophy will be given to the winner at the end of the day.
- Certified High School officials will be used for all games.
- Helmets are the only gear that will be worn.
- There is a 32 team cutoff, so early registration is advised.
- Registration begins at 9 AM to 10 AM at the UNA practice field adjacent to Flowers Hall.
